

## **Entiat School District Transportation Information** BUS ROUTES & LOADING ZONES

Buses will load and unload students in the bus loading zone, in the north elementary parking lot. Parents arriving to pick up students are encouraged to park in front of the school. Time schedules for morning bus runs for Entiat Schools (<u>times approximate</u>) are listed below. Mid-day pick-up pre-K bus routes will be set when all students are registered and will be communicated to parents of pre-K students separately. <u>PLEASE HAVE YOUR CHILD AT THE BUS STOP FIVE MINUTES EARLY</u>.

**NOTE**: Buses on up-river routes go to the furthest point on the route and turn and pick up students on the trip back to the school.

### **BUS RULES**

Bus rules for the 2023-2024 school year are listed below. We are asking parents/guardians to review the rules with students. Each bus driver has tremendous responsibilities, and riders need to observe the rules so that each trip is safe. Violation of bus rules may bring about the loss of student riding privileges, for both limited and extended periods of time

- Keep aisle clear; Sit down in your seat; back to back; seat to seat and feet on the floor.
- Follow rules and directions the first time given.
- Talk quietly and be respectful.
- Use appropriate language; refrain from teasing and rude gestures.
- Keep hands, feet and objects to self.
- No eating, drinking, or chewing gum on the bus.
- The bus driver is always in charge.
- If using electronics, volume must be down.

#### Implementing a New Cell Phone Policy for 24-25 School Year

Our commitment to the students, parents, staff, and community of the Entiat School District is to provide a safe environment for all students and one that allows them to reach their highest potential. As part of this commitment to learning and the health and well-being of our students, we will be implementing a new cellphone policy starting in the 2024-25 school year. This policy, which applies to pre-kindergarten through 12th grade students, will restrict cellphone use during school hours to foster a more conducive learning environment.



We are implementing this policy due to many factors, a few of which are listed below:

- It's the Right Thing to Do: The research and evidence are quite clear that the use of smartphones and social media is having a harmful effect on our young people's mental health. Knowing this, we can no longer avoid addressing this.
- Enhancing Academic Focus: Research indicates that cell phones can be a significant distraction in the classroom. By removing cell phones, students can better concentrate on their studies, leading to improved academic performance and a more engaging educational experience.
- Addressing Mental Health Concerns: Insights from Jonathan Haidt's book, The Anxious Generation, highlight the link between excessive smartphone use and increased anxiety and depression among young people. Limiting cellphone use during school hours aims to mitigate these risks and promote a healthier school environment.

#### Implementación de una Nueva Póliza de Teléfonos Celulares para el Año Escolar 24-25

Nuestro compromiso con los estudiantes, padres, personal y la comunidad del Distrito Escolar de Entiat es proporcionar un ambiente seguro para todos los estudiantes, uno que les permita alcanzar su máximo potencial. Como parte de este compromiso con el aprendizaje y el bienestar de nuestros estudiantes, implementaremos una nueva póliza de teléfonos celulares a partir del año escolar 2024-25. Esta póliza, que se aplica a los estudiantes desde pre-kínder hasta el grado 12, restringirá el uso de teléfonos celulares durante el horario escolar para fomentar un ambiente de aprendizaje más propicio.

Estamos implementando esta póliza debido a varios factores, algunos de los cuales se enumeran a continuación:

- Es lo Correcto: La investigación y la evidencia son bastante claras en cuanto a que el uso de teléfonos celulares y las redes sociales está teniendo un efecto dañino en la salud mental de nuestros jóvenes. Sabiendo esto, no podemos seguir evitando abordar este problema.
- Mejorar el Enfoque Académico: La investigación indica que los teléfonos celulares pueden ser una distracción significativa en el aula. Al eliminar los teléfonos celulares, los estudiantes pueden concentrarse mejor en sus estudios, lo que lleva a un mejor rendimiento académico y una experiencia educativa más participativa.
- Abordar las Preocupaciones sobre la Salud Mental: Las ideas del libro de Jonathan Haidt, "The Anxious Generation" destacan la relación entre el uso
  excesivo de teléfonos celulares y el aumento de la ansiedad y la depresión entre los jóvenes. Limitar el uso de teléfonos celulares durante el horario escolar
  tiene como objetivo mitigar estos riesgos y promover un ambiente escolar más saludable.
